Identify staff needs

Ensure all staff know how to:

- minimise a learner's exposure to known allergens
- recognise signs and symptoms of an mild-to-moderate allergic reaction
- locate a learner's EpiPen
- respond appropriately in the event of anaphylaxis
- administer adrenaline with an EpiPen
- follow agreed systems and processes, for example, for accessing allergy action plans or accessing medication
- provide immediate first-aid assistance.
