Visible learning is one of the keys to a hybrid approach. Visible learning allows ākongā and whanau to know what is being learnt, how it is learnt and to have access to the resources that support the learning.

With hybrid learning, ākongā:

- can learn any time from any location.
- can learn at different times and at their own pace.
- have flexible options for learning to suit their needs and circumstances.
- can continue to learn when there is disruption to onsite learning at school or in their personal lives.
- can collaborate and connect regardless of the setting.
- can take more ownership of their learning.
