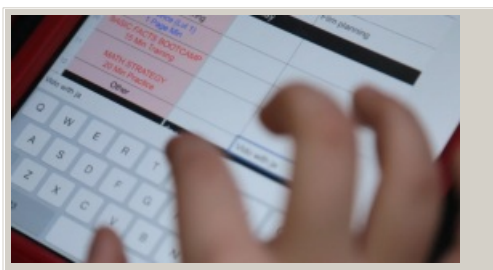


Scaffold students to manage learning
