Support for inclusive design

If we are critically conscious as we apply a UDL approach, it can help us to systematically remove barriers to learning for ākonga Māori and increase flexible valued learning pathways. **Universal Design for Learning** is a people-first framework that helps us plan for diversity. UDL is applied through a thinking cycle that helps us identify and remove barriers to learning and supports the development of inclusive flexible learning environments, rich in supports and options.
