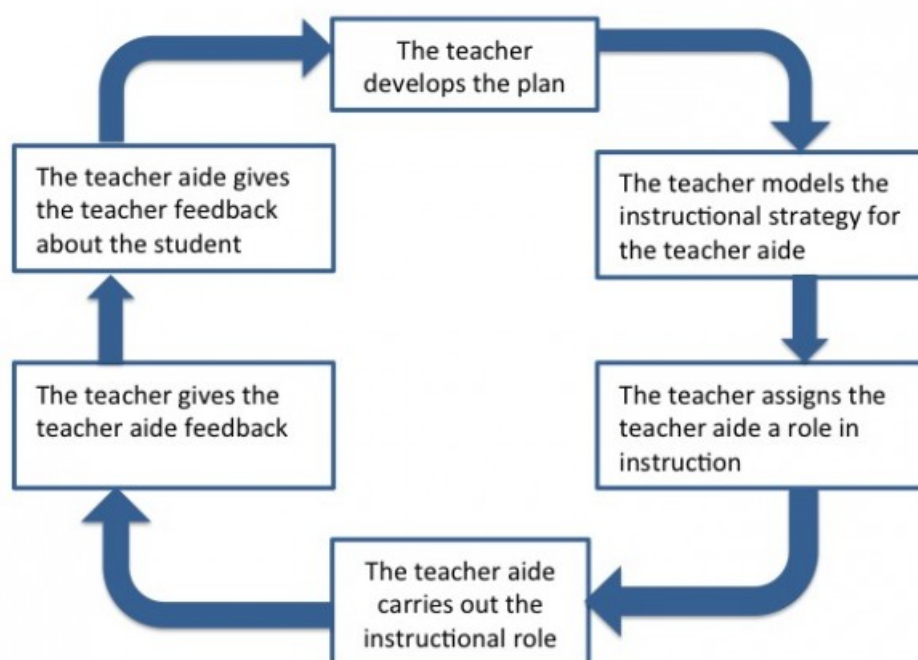

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Provide direction to teacher aides

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Reduce student isolation or dependency

Avoid approaches where teacher aides are assigned to specific pupils for long periods.

Encourage teachers to adopt approaches to ensure all students receive equal time working with the teacher, the teacher aide, their peers, and independently.

Consider how to give teacher aides a more visible and active role in teaching during whole-class delivery by, for example, inviting them to record answers on a whiteboard, or to demonstrate equipment.

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Optimise the physical layout to support belonging

Use classroom layout and teacher aides support to encourage students' learning and peer interaction.
