Offer useful supports

Try small, inexpensive equipment.

Always consider the needs and sensitivities of your learners before introducing any supports. Offer supports to everyone, such as:

- fidget tools for concentration
- reading rulers to highlight single lines of text
- sticky notes or removable Post-it flags to mark important words or sections of text
- calculators
- magnifiers
- slope boards
- coloured pencils and felt-tipped pens
- pencil grips to support fine motor control
- headphones
- earmuffs to reduce noise
- timers
- inflatable seat cushions.
