Voice technology tools offer learners alternative ways to gather information and share it with others.

Voice-memo technology uses the built-in microphone on a device.

Voice memos can be used to:

- record instructions, key ideas, or explanations
- record memos to self, for example, reminders, brainstorming, and lists
- read work aloud and check for errors or fluency
- share ideas with others.

Virtual assistants such as Siri can be used to:

- access information
- check work, for example, spelling, maths, or facts
- ask questions.
